## KEY TAKE-AWAYS

Guided Pathways is "Self-Service" and they need to be strong advocates to succeed.

Communication and the timing of messaging is inconsistent. Many students don't remember / aren't able to recall information about all of the services available to them.

Many students -- and particularly Black / African American students -- do not have a strong sense of belonging on campus.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

Build awareness of Engagement Centers as KEY NAVIGATION POINTS for students.

Intentionally and specifically include academic support opportunities in Engagement Centers

Improve communication and clarify course patterns and links to career goals
