



# NOW RECRUITING FOR 2017-18 PUENTE PROGRAM

Puente (Bridge) Program is an academic and community leadership program to help students transfer to four-year colleges and universities. Puente meets this goal through a two-semester English composition class emphasizing Chicano/Latino literature; two semester guidance courses; and mentoring by professional community members. Students remain with the same instructor, counselor, and mentor for one full year. Puente is open to all students.

## Eligible Requirements:

- Eligible for English 50 “ Basic English Composition”
- Enroll in Puente Guidance Courses
- Planning to transfer to a university
- Commit to a year-long program
- Participate in the Puente Club
- Attend a Puente Orientation
- Submit a Puente Student Interest Form
