On Tuesday, August 11, 2009 at about 1300 hours a lone female student on the Riverside campus near the Quad lunch truck was approached by a white male about 27, shaved head with hair stubble growing back in, light bluish/green eyes, grey tee shirt, shorts carrying a black small leather binder (similar to the one you get with the check at a restaurant) with stickers on it. He told her he was selling magazines for points to go to Mexico, Australia or Paris France and that the contest was through RCC. He basically scammed her out of \$30.00 and she wrote the check to a Kyle Kiser. Her receipt stated the company she could call to cancel the order was Rolling Sales Incorporated - 2627 South Lamb Blvd., #1, Las Vegas, NV 89121 480-603-8618. Her husband called to cancel the check and it had already been cashed about 10 minutes after she had written the check. She Googled the company and found out the company is a fraud and these people usually scam women that are alone at malls and college campuses out of their money. She stated he told her to tell anyone else that might ask her to purchase a subscription to advise them she already purchased one. She felt there may be others working with this subject on our campuses. If you come across anyone on campus trying to get subscriptions for magazines and their receipts says Rolling Sales Inc. they are probably involved in this scam.
