

Yesterday (11/26/07), at about 5:41 PM, our Norco police office was contacted by two female students reporting a suspicious male who was following women through the Library while fondling himself. The reporting students preferred not to make a crime report, telling our officer that they only wanted to share the information. Our officer checked the Library but did not see the male. Our officer continued checking the campus and found a person who matched the description in the Science & Technology Building. This person was identified and interviewed by our officer.

Later in the evening, at about 8:10 PM, a woman who identified herself only as a Norco Campus Library employee called RCCD police dispatch to report that a male had exposed himself to her. This suspect's description matched the person reported earlier, and the person contacted by our officer. This person also preferred not to make an official police crime report.

The suspect's description is: Black, male, adult, in his forties, medium build, bald and wearing glasses. He was last seen wearing blue pants, a beige shirt and carrying a blue binder.
