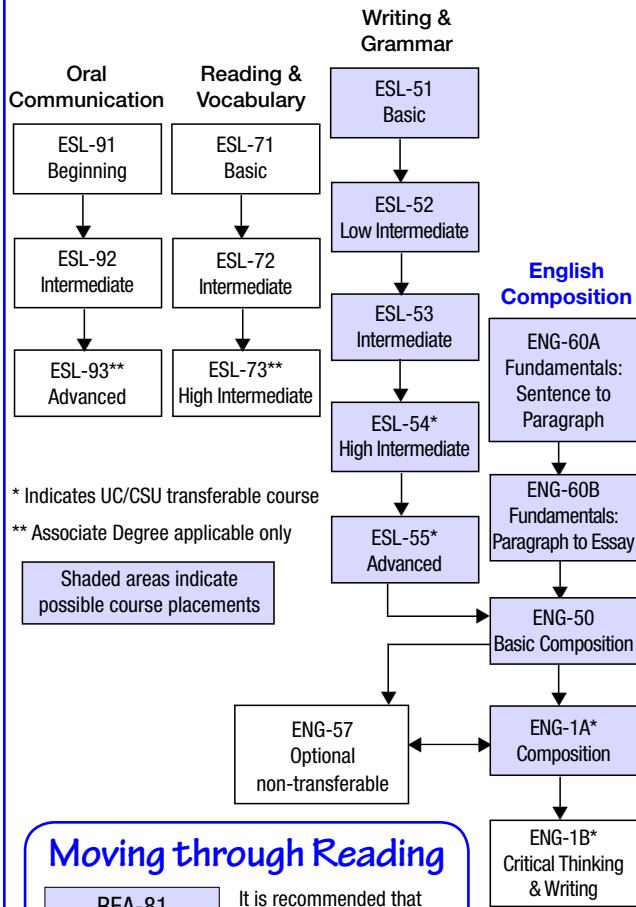

English as a Second Language

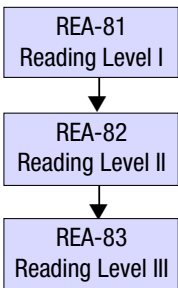
