The management accountant provides information and advice as a member of the management team in the planning and direction of the company's operations. The public accountant offers auditing, tax works, and other financial advice services. The Internal Revenue Service, United States Accounting Office, and local and state government agencies provide employment opportunities in government accounting. Employment opportunities continue to increase throughout the United States and in many foreign countries with CPA firms, governments and industries.

Students interested in this major should be aware that accounting, at many institutions, does not exist as a separate department/program, but is found as an "Option" under Business Administration.
