\*To be eligible for admission to a Bachelor of the Fine Arts (B.F.A.) program, applicants must demonstrate the following prior to the semester for which the application is submitted: Applicants must have met requirements for admission to the university as a freshman or transfer student. Applicants must have completed at least 60 semester units of baccalaureate-level work applicable toward a degree at CSULB. Applicants must provide a portfolio of their creative work to the Department of Art. Your portfolio can be submitted before you enter the Department but it is highly suggested that students interested in the B.F.A. programs enter the university as a Studio Art major, take between six to nine upper division units in the area of specialization, and then submit a portfolio. You only have two chances to apply for a B.F.A. program. By applying early you may use one of your chances before you are ready.
