THE MAJOR:

The business major comprises all the basic business disciplines. At the undergraduate level, students can major in a general business administration program or specialize in a particular area such as marketing, retail, banking, international business, taxation, merchandising or accounting. These studies lead to jobs in business and industry, but they are also applicable to management positions in other sectors. Management-related studies include the general management areas (accounting, finance, marketing and management).

Business studies also provide a good background for further training in business-management related studies at the MBA level, law, public accounting (CPA), actuarial work (insurance) and training and management development.

The major aims to develop one's managerial and technical competence necessary for successful performance in business, industry, government, and education. Since this field is so broad, it is to the student's advantage that s/he obtain a wide cultural, historical, and factual background needed for the selected area of specialization.
