THE MAJOR:

Foresters plan and supervise the growing, protection, and utilization of trees. They make maps of forest areas, estimate the amount of standing timber and future growth, and manage timber sales. Other duties may range from wildlife protection and watershed management to supervision of camps, parks, and grazing lands. They must deal constantly with land owners, loggers, forestry aides, and a wide variety of other people. Qualified foresters find job opportunities available with private industry, the Forest Service of the Department of Agriculture, state and local governments, colleges and universities, and consulting firms.
