THE MAJOR:

An increasing emphasis on physical fitness throughout the country has opened new opportunities for physical education graduates as athletic directors in sports clubs, exercise specialists in health clubs, and athletic trainers in amateur and professional teams. Still, the major source of employment is teaching and coaching in public and private schools and universities, with many and varied opportunities in sports and dance. Several students continue on in graduate work to do research or become administrators of various athletic interests.

The major in physical education is designed for the student interested in preparing to (1) become a physical education teacher; (2) select a career in nonteaching fields related to physical education, such as commercial physical education, sports business and commercial leisure services; and (3) pursue graduate work in physical education.
