THE MAJOR:

Pharmacy is a health profession dealing with the preparation and distribution of drugs and medicines prescribed by practitioners. Besides knowing the chemistry of compounds and their effects on human beings, a pharmacist is generally required to understand sound business management and personnel supervision. Large pharmaceutical firms and drugstores make up the majority of job opportunities in this field. The pharmacy profession is undergoing rapid changes from both inside and outside the profession. In the coming years pharmacists will become increasingly involved as direct participants in the care of patients by becoming active members of the health-care team. Consequently, pharmacists will be much less directly involved in routine drug distribution. In this health role pharmacists will become sources of drug information and will be performing as consultants with physicians regarding the correct selection and usage of drugs for particular patients. They will have a more responsible role in advising the patient on how to self-administer medications correctly, and they will spend an increasing amount of time in promoting the patient's health and welfare.
