**THE MAJOR:**

Social work in the health field involves programs and services that meet the special needs of the ill, disabled, elderly, or otherwise handicapped. Social workers deal with the emotional, social, cultural, and physical needs of patients in whom the effects of illness go far beyond bodily discomfort.

Sixty percent of all social workers provide direct services for public and voluntary agencies, including state departments of public assistance and community welfare and religious organizations. Most of the remainder are involved in social policy and planning, community organization, and administration in governmental agencies, primarily on the state and local levels. Still others work for schools, hospitals, clinics, and other health facilities. A small but growing number of social workers are employed in business and industry.
