Attention Moreno Valley, Norco, and Riverside City College students:

With the start of the spring semester, the Counseling Department wants to make you aware of a recent change in counseling. Now that Moreno Valley, Norco, and Riverside City are independent colleges, the scheduling of counseling appointments must be made at the college you determined as your home college. Effective immediately, if you are seeking a counseling appointment, you will only be able to do so with a counselor at your home college. For example, if you are taking classes at Moreno Valley College, but you declared Riverside as your home college, then you must schedule a counseling appointment at Riverside.

The Counseling Department recommends that all students pursuing certificate or degree programs, either associate or baccalaureate, see a counselor to complete a Student Educational Plan (SEP) during the spring or fall semesters at your home college. You may continue to see counselors at any of the three colleges but only on an express services basis. Please understand that Express Counseling is limited to a 5-10 minute counseling meeting. Student Educational Plans, transcript evaluations and in depth planning will not be done on an Express Counseling basis.

Note regarding Home College change:

Students wanting to change home colleges must apply to the desired college for the next term or future terms through WebAdvisor. For example, a Norco student who attended in fall 2010 and now wants to transfer to Riverside City College in spring 2011 needs to apply for Riverside. If you are unsure of the home college you selected, please log onto WebAdvisor. Your home college is located in "Update Program of Study" under the header entitled "Personal Information."
