1. What is the RCCD College Card?




The RCCD College Card is the official identification card for the Riverside Community College District. It allows you access to RCCD events, programs, and services –including library and lab access – on all three colleges of the RCCD.

In addition, the RCCD College Card comes with the **OPTION** to be linked to a *Wells Fargo College Checking*® account. This allows students to make PIN-debit purchases off campus and for free access to cash at Wells Fargo ATMs nationwide. Faculty/staff members may link their RCCDCollege Card to a Wells Fargo checking package.

Enjoy the convenience of one card and use your RCCD College Card for all of your on-campus needs and for your day-to-day financial needs!

2. When and where can I pick up my RCCD College Card?

The RCCD College Card is available to all students, faculty, and staff. It is issued at the Admissions and Records Office located at each college. (A valid picture ID must be presented in order to receive an RCCD College Card.)

3. What is the Wells Fargo OPTION that the RCCD College Card program offers?

When your RCCD College Card is linked to a *Wells Fargo College Checking* account, you can use it at businesses that accept PIN-debit transactions and for free access to cash at Wells Fargo ATMs nationwide.. Transactions using your RCCD CollegeCard for ATM or PIN-debit transactions are deducted from your primary linked Wells Fargo checking account.

4. What do I need to open an account at Wells Fargo?

You will need two valid forms of identification:

1. Government-issued identification card from the federal, state, tribal, local, or foreign government. Examples include: Driver’s license, state-issued ID card, passport, and military ID.
2. Second identification from a recognized business, educational institution, or government agency. Examples include: Student ID card, Social Security card, Resident Alien card, and Matricula Consular card.

5. What if I already have an existing Wells Fargo checking account?

You can **LINK** your RCCD College Card to your existing Wells Fargo checking account by visiting any Wells Fargo banking location in the Riverside area and throughout California.

6. What should I do if my RCCD College Card is lost or stolen?

You need to notify **BOTH** the Riverside Community College District and Wells Fargo for RCCD College Cards that are linked to a Wells Fargo checking account as soon as possible. (RCCD College Card holders without the banking option need to only notify RCCD.)

1. **To notify RCCD:** Please go to the Admissions and Records Office at the campus where your new RCCD College Card was issued.
2. **To notify Wells Fargo:** Visit your nearest Wells Fargo banking location or contact Wells Fargo Phone BankSM 24/7 at 1-800-TO-WELLS (1-800-869-3557).

7. Is there a monthly service fee associated with the Wells Fargo College Checking account?

RCCD students who open a *Wells Fargo College Checking* account will have their monthly service fee waived by linking their account to their RCCD College Card. Please speak to a Wells Fargo banker for more details.

8. Where can I open a new Wells Fargo account?

At the Riverside campus, visit the Wells Fargo banking location inside the Outreach Office to open your account and link your College Card. Wells Fargo bankers will be on all campuses during peak times throughout the school year so you can begin the account opening process there, or visit any Wells Fargo banking location including those located nearest each campus.
