Welcome/Introductions:

Monica Delgadillo-Flores introduced featured guest, David Torres, District Dean, Institutional Research.

Guest Speaker: *David Torres* presented an update on the Accountability Reporting for Community Colleges (ARCC). The report is a performance indicator for California Community Colleges (CCC) and measures the following 7 system wide performance indicators:

1) Student Progress and Achievement 2) Completed 30 or More Units 3) Fall to Fall Persistence 4) Vocational Course Completion 5) Basic Skills Course Completion 6) ESL Course Improvement and 7) Basic Skills Course Improvement.

When compared to our designated peer groups RCCD's accountability indicators demonstrate good levels.

Department Updates-

Admissions and Records reported they are preparing for 3 college shift and starting July 1st 2010 the Spanish college application will be discontinued. A 3 college application will begin spring 2011. All students inquiring about graduation should be directed to graduation website. No commencement letters will be mailed but students will be sent an email to their RCCD account. Sandra Goulsby will be at Moreno Valley College starting July 1st, 2010.

Counseling reported the following:
Starting Fall 2010

- Dismissal students will be able to register for classes through WebAdvisor
- Unit limitations will be applied through Datatel (STPE screen).

- A newly dismissed student must see a counselor who will determine unit limitations for the student's first semester on dismissal and clear the student for registration.
- Readmit Contracts developed during the counseling meeting are for student use only – the contracts are no longer needed for registration.
- Returning dismissal students who were required to sit out a semester after a broken contract must see a counselor to develop a new readmit contract to determine unit limitations for the returning semester.
- Continued dismissal students will not have to see a counselor for a readmit contract but are limited to 13 units in fall/spring and 5 units in winter/summer
- Course selections will no longer be limited by a readmit contract.

Remains the same:

Newly dismissed students must see a counselor to be able to register for classes.

- Returning dismissal students who were required to sit out a semester after a broken contract must see a counselor to be able to register for classes.
