2009-2010 Dislocated Worker Status Form

Based on the information we have received from your 2009-2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid, you have answered Yes to question 85, "As of today, are either of your parents a dislocated worker," or question 103, "As of today are you (or your spouse) a dislocated worker?"

In general, a person may be considered a dislocated worker if he or she is receiving unemployment benefits due to being laid off or losing a job and is unlikely to return to a previous occupation; has been laid off or received a lay-off notice from a job; was self-employed but is now unemployed due to economic conditions or natural disaster; or is a displaced homemaker. A displaced homemaker is generally a person who previously provided unpaid services to the family (e.g., a stay-at-home mom or dad), is no longer supported by the husband or wife, is unemployed or underemployed and is having trouble finding or upgrading employment.

Please check the option that applies to you and/or your spouse, or your parents and provide the requested documentation:

- _____ I am receiving unemployment benefits due to being laid off or losing a job and it is unlikely I will return to my previous occupation. ***Please submit your unemployment claim notice which lists the reason you are receiving benefits is due to being laid off.***

- _____ I was self-employed but I am now unemployed due to economic conditions or natural disaster. ***Please provide proof of income loss or natural disaster.***
- _____ I am a displaced homemaker and meet all of the following conditions (a) I provided unpaid services to my family (b) I am no longer supported by my husband or wife (c) I am unemployed or underemployed and I am having trouble finding or upgrading employment. ***Please provide proof of divorce or separation and verification of lost income.***
- _____ None of these apply to me. Question 85 or Question 103 should not have been marked "yes."
