In 200 years, one of your relatives is going to be digging in what is now your backyard. They are going to find something that you buried in 2012 and it is going to put any financial worries they have to rest.

Your job today is to decide what to bury. Your goal is to find something that will have immense value in the future. The item that you choose to bury today must:

- Be currently sold in a store today
- Be under \$500

Write an essay that is between 500—1,000 words. Be sure to answer all of the following questions in your essay:

- What is the item you are going to bury?
- Where could you purchase the item today?
- How much does the item cost?
- What made you choose the item?
- Why do you believe that the item will have immense value 200 years from now?

Essays will be graded on 1) Originality—35% ,2) Depth of Content—50%, 3) Grammar, punctuation, and spelling—15%.

Please write your essay using Microsoft Word, Times New Roman 12-point font. If you are referencing any other sources, please use an annotated bibliography at the end.
