

2010-2011 RCCD Scholarships for High School Seniors

Below is a listing of scholarships offered by RCCD available for High School seniors. Read each one to decide which scholarships you may be eligible for. You will be considered for every scholarship for which you meet the criteria. Please pay special attention to those scholarships that require extra effort for eligibility. To assist you with understanding the eligibility requirements for each scholarship please read the following:

Scholarship Name:	Scholarships are often named after the donor or group offering the scholarship. Many times scholarships are offered in memory of a loved one who has passed away. Scholarships may also be named for a group or type of student who will benefit from the scholarship.
Major:	This is the major or course of study required by the donor. Some scholarships will say "None." In that case, any major is acceptable.
CGPA:	This is the minimum cumulative GPA as listed on your high school transcripts that is required to apply for each scholarship.
Financial Need:	If there is a "Yes" in this column, the donor requires that applicants for this scholarship have financial need as determined by completion of the 2009-2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA is available on-line at www.fafsa.ed.gov . The Title IV Code for RCCD is "001270." Students that have not completed the FAFSA will not be considered for any need-based scholarships.
Other Criteria:	This is a variety of requirements determined by the donor as eligibility for each scholarship. Please pay close attention to this section. Some of the items may require extra effort on your part to be eligible. Or, the specific scholarship may require that your recommendation letters are from specific individuals.
Amount:	Some scholarship amounts will be listed as "varies" because the award amount can change from year to year. You will be notified of the exact amount in your congratulation award letter and/or your disbursement information letter if you are chosen as a scholarship recipient.
