CALIFORNIA HIGH SCHOOL EXIT EXAM (CAHSEE)  
PREPARATION PROGRAM

***Overview of the Program***

The California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE) Preparation Program began in 2007 through a grant awarded by the California Community College Chancellor's Office. The CAHSEE Prep Program provides academic assistance to seniors who did not graduate from high school because they have not passed the CAHSEE. Beginning with the graduating class of 2006, students are now required to pass the CAHSEE in order to graduate with a diploma from a California public high school. RCC has developed a program designed to assist students to improve their skills in Math and English/Language Arts. CAHSEE Prep classes and coursework is designed to help students to pass the CAHSEE, complete high school, and develop a community college education plan. CAHSEE Prep is a non-credit college program.

***Program***

The CAHSEE Prep Program addresses, Math, English/Language Arts and educational planning. Tutoring sessions in math, reading and writing are designed to teach the skills that are required to pass the CAHSEE. Tutoring sessions meet twice a week for two hours a day, usually mornings and afternoons. Students in the program have access to small group instruction, instructional materials, and web-based test prep software (all free of charge). Tutoring times vary from semester to semester but generally will give students the option of morning or afternoon sessions. The goal of the CAHSEE Preparation Program at RCC is to reduce students' barriers in their pursuit of a college education.
