

2023-2024 RCC Student Employment Dates to Remember

***Please note that students should not be working the holidays unless there is a special event.**

Summer Session (June 20 – July 28)

June 30th – Last day students can work for the 22-23 academic year based on spring enrollment.

July 1st – First day of employment for the 2023-2024 academic year. Students may work if hire paperwork has been processed and the supervisor has been notified in writing of the approval. Students must be enrolled in 3 or more units for summer and have a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA to be eligible to work.

July 4th – Holiday

August 20th – Last day students can work for the summer session if they do not plan to return for the fall semester. Students may work July 29th – August 20th while classes are not in session based on summer enrollment.

Fall Semester (August 21 – December 16)

August 7th – The first day students may work for the fall semester if they were not enrolled in summer, but are enrolled as of this date for fall in 6 or more units and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0. If not enrolled in the required units, but hire paperwork has been processed and approved, the student may work the first week of the semester which is a grace period to get the required units needed to work. They must be in the required units by the second week.

September 4th – Labor Day Holiday

November 10th – Veterans Day Holiday

November 23rd – Thanksgiving Day Holiday

November 24th – College Closure

December 25th – Christmas Day Holiday

December 26th – December 29th – College Closure for winter break

January 1st – New Year's Day Holiday

Winter Session (January 2 – February 9)

January 2nd – First day students can work for the winter session. Students must be enrolled in 3 or more units and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.

January 15th – Martin Luther King Jr. Holiday

Spring Semester (February 12 – June 7)

January 29th – First day students can start working for the spring semester if they were not enrolled in winter session, but are enrolled as of this date for spring in 6 or more units and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0. If not enrolled in the required units by this date, they will be eligible to start the first week of the semester. The first week of the semester is a grace period. Students must be enrolled in the required number of units by the second week of the semester.

February 16th and 19th – Lincoln's Birthday and Washington's Birthday Holidays

April 1st – Cesar Chavez Holiday

April 11th – April 14th – Spring Break – students may work during spring break if their funding or budget allows it.

May 27th – Memorial Day Holiday

June 7th – Commencement – **students may work from June 10th through June 30th based on spring semester enrollment if they have funding or budget remaining.**

June 19th – Juneteenth Holiday
