- Winter work update:
 - Process to update ILOs has been approved by Academic Senate at college and district levels.
 - Denise shared the ILO Change Process flow chart. We are at the point
 where we need to put together a work group to draft the language for
 the ILO's; representatives and students from each of the 3 colleges
 will be included. We are looking for students who will be here
 through fall 2024, who may be interested in higher education or
 teaching, or learning about curriculum to participate in the
 workgroup.
