The Riverside Community College District and Moreno Valley College are recognized throughout the region as leaders in public safety education and in addition to Administration of Justice, Fire Technology, Emergency Medical Services, and Crime Analysis, MVC's School of Public Safety currently offers associate's degrees in Emergency Management and Homeland Security. However, despite the fact over 80% of California public agencies that employ Emergency Managers require a bachelor's degree for entry level positions, there are no public institutions in California offering a Bachelor's degree in Emergency Management. The lack of a baccalaureate program limits the ability of both new and experienced professionals to gain the necessary academic credentials to advance in their careers and serve their communities effectively. Additionally, AB-89, passed by the legislature in 2021, will require California Peace Officers to hold a bachelor's degree. As demonstrated by the attached Labor Market Analysis from the Inland Empire/Desert Center of Excellence for Labor Market Research, there is a demonstrated need both regionally and statewide for Emergency Management professionals, and this degree will fill that need, leading to high paying jobs.
