1. Complete the Online Application

- Go to rcc.edu/international and view the "How to Apply" page

2. E-mail copies of the following to internationalcenter@rcc.edu

- Passport
- Proof of Funding Form and Bank Account Statements
- Proof of English Language Proficiency: TOEFL 45, IELTS 4.5, Duolingo 75 (see our website for more accepted exams)
- High school diploma with certified English translation (not required if applicant is over the age of 18)
- College transcript with certified English translation (if applicant has attended another college or university)

3. Pay the application fee

Application Deadlines

Riverside City College accepts applications from new students for the Fall, Spring, and Summer terms.

Semester	Deadline	Orientation
Spring	December 1	Early February
Summer	May 1	Late June
Fall	July 1	Early August
