

### Fall 2021 Student Survey

Presentation to Chancellor's Meeting, November 16, 2021



#### Background

- A survey was commissioned to ask fall 2021 students about what influenced their decision to attend Riverside Community College District.
- Multiple drafts were circulated between district Educational Services, district and college Institutional Effectiveness staff, college Student Services Vice Presidents and student government leadership to refine the focus and survey items.




#### Methodology

- Presently enrolled students were sent an e-mail invitation from the Student Trustee with a link to participate in the survey.
- In addition to a pre-survey letter of introduction, students were sent multiple reminders to help raise the response rate.
- In all, the survey yielded 2,126 usable results during the two-week survey window.




# Q2-When considering attending college, what combination best describes your preference?



Response Rate: 2062/2126=97%




### Q3-Which of the following factors would increase the likelihood of you enrolling in face-to-face courses (mark all that apply)






# Q4-Are you attending RCCD as a full-time student (attempting 12 or more units) this semester?



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
#### Q5 & Q6 - What Percentage of Classes Are Taken Online?

# Q7-Did the vaccine requirement affect your decision to attend courses In-Person?






### Q8-Does knowing everyone on-site must be vaccinated make it more likely for you to attend on-site?



Response Rate: 1963/2126=92%




## Q9-Did any of your In-Person classes this semester get administratively changed to Online classes?



Response Rate: 1962/2126=92%




## Q10-Did this change cause you to have a negative perception of attending Riverside Community College District?

#### Q11-How successful have you been accessing any student services (such as financial aid and counseling) either In-Person or Online this semester?



#### Response Rate: 1917/2126=90%




# Q12-For tutoring and other academic support services (*such* as peer mentoring, study groups, supplemental instruction), which method have you used most this semester?



Response Rate: 1913/2126=90%




Q13-How much do you agree with this statement: "Offering more Online courses will quicken my progress toward completing my educational goal."



Response Rate: 1915/2126=90%




### Q14-How likely are you to attend In-Person classes if more evening or weekend classes were added to the schedule?



### Observations

- Student participation in survey creation and dissemination was very helpful.
- Incentivizing students to return may be difficult.
- Vaccine mandate (and associated changes) didn't negatively affect student perceptions, attitudes.
- Students successfully access services online.
- More evening and weekend course offerings need to be explored.



### **Next Steps**

 Recode and categorize "Other" incentives and finalize document.

- Begin subsequent survey of students who were previously enrolled and have not re-enrolled.
  - Decide on sample and methodology
- Involve student participation in every step of survey design and administration.
