## **KING and QUEEN Mandatory Meeting**

King and Queen Candidates are **required** to attend the mandatory meeting held on **Wednesday, October 6th at 1 pm, via Zoom**. All pertinent information will be given at that time.

## **Homecoming KING and QUEEN Candidate Selection**

One King and one Queen will be selected to reign over the Homecoming football game and academic year. Riverside and Moreno Valley will each choose their own winners who will be crowned at the football game on October 16th. Campus clubs, organizations, and friends are encouraged to show their support for their candidates during the selection process.

## **King and Queen Introductions**

King and Queen candidates shall put together a 2 minute video introducing themselves as a candidate. Their video should explain why students should vote for them as King/Queen. The video should be entertaining (be creative!) with an educational component. (For example, what do you love about RCC? How you will contribute if you are crowned King or Queen? If you were to create an event what would it be? Perhaps you have a cause you would like to advocate, etc.). ## **Scholarships**

Riverside City College King and Queen will each receive a \$250 scholarship. All scholarship recipients must pay their Student Services fee. Scholarships will be awarded in June at the Scholarship Celebration. The King and Queen winners must attend the coronation on October 16th, in order to receive the scholarship. Candidates who are not vaccinated can still attend with proof of a negative COVID19 test within 48 hours.
