

2018-2019 RCC Student Employment Dates to Remember

***Please note that students should not be working the holidays unless there is a special event.**

Summer Session (June 18 – July 26)

June 30th – Last day students can work for the 17-18 academic year based on spring enrollment.

July 1st – First day of employment for the 2018-2019 academic year. Students may work if hire paperwork has been processed and the supervisor has been notified in writing of the approval. Students must be enrolled in 3 or more units for summer and have a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA to be eligible to work.

July 4th – Holiday

August 26th – Last day students can work for the summer session if they do not plan to return for the fall semester. Students may work July 27th – August 26th while classes are not in session based on summer enrollment.

Fall Semester (August 27 – December 14)

August 13th – The first day students may work for the fall semester if they were not enrolled in summer, but are enrolled as of this date for fall in 6 or more units and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.

September 3rd – Holiday

November 12th – Holiday

November 22nd – Holiday

December 25th – Holiday

December 26th – January 1st – College closure for winter holiday. Students may work during this time except for the December 26th and January 1st holidays.

Winter Session (January 2 – February 7)

January 1st – Holiday

January 2nd – First day students can work for the winter session. Students must be enrolled in 3 or more units and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.

January 21st – Holiday

Spring Semester (February 11 – June 7)

January 28th – First day students can start working for the spring semester if they were not enrolled in winter session, but are enrolled as of this date for spring in 6 or more units and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.

February 15th, 18th – Holidays

April 1st – Holiday

April 15th – April 21st – Spring Break – students may work during spring break if their funding or budget allows it.

May 27th – Holiday

June 7th – Commencement – students may work from June 7th through June 30th based on spring semester enrollment if they have funding or budget remaining.
