

Steps to Financial Aid

Apply

Financial aid applications are available beginning October 1 for the next academic year.

File online at FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov
School code: 001270

OR

The Dream Application at www.caldreamact.org
School code: 00127000

Submit Required Documents

You **MAY** need to complete and submit additional documents/actions to complete your file.

Check "**Required Documents by Year**" in the Financial Aid section of MyPortal or WebAdvisor to determine if additional documents/actions are required to complete your aid application. Documents can be downloaded at: <http://rcc.edu/services/studentfinancialservices/Pages/FA-FORMS.aspx>

Complete and submit ALL required documents together, with written signatures in person or via email to studentfinancialservices@rcc.edu.

Eligibility and Award Notification

Revised award notifications are emailed to students based on the file processing deadline date you have been placed on.

Financial aid eligibility can be reviewed on the Financial Aid Award Letter on MyPortal and WebAdvisor.

The amount of your award in MyPortal and WebAdvisor is based on full-time enrollment (12 units); students who attend less than full-time will receive less financial aid.

Check Student Email, MyPortal, and Web Advisor

It will take 2-3 weeks for applications to be received.

You will receive an email to your student email when the FAFSA application is received.

"Required Documents by Year" will be updated in My Portal and WebAdvisor once the FAFSA is received.

You can review your FAFSA status, BOG Waiver eligibility and preliminary award notification on MyPortal and WebAdvisor.

Know Your Deadline

Documents/Actions Required— You will be placed on a file processing deadline based on the date that all documents/actions required in MyPortal and WebAdvisor have been received or waived.

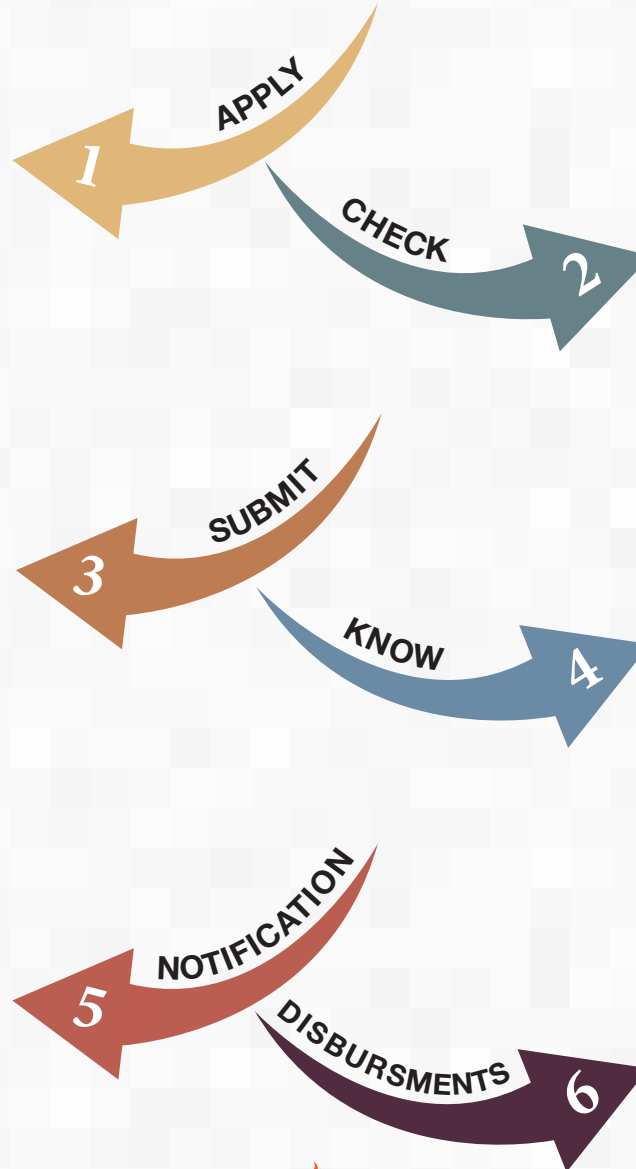
No Documents/Actions Required— Your deadline date is determined by the date shown in MyPortal and WebAdvisor that the FAFSA/Dream Application was received by RCC.

Disbursements

New Students: You will receive a green welcome envelope from BankMobile and an email to your student email instructing you on how to select a disbursement method. Funds are disbursed to eligible students based on your preferred disbursement method.

Student Financial Services

Accessing student information online has never been easier!

For online financial aid information:

- At the top of the rcc.edu homepage, click the My Portal or WebAdvisor link and sign in using your RCCD Email or WebAdvisor Login.
- Locate the “Financial Aid” section in MyPortal, or in Web Advisor click on “Student” and locate the “Financial Aid” section.
- Click on “Required Documents by Year” to view pending documents to complete your file, or “Award Letter” to view your financial aid award.

To print required documents:

- On the rcc.edu homepage, click on “Financial Aid” in the Student Gateways menu on the right hand side.
- On the right sidebar click on “Required Documents by Year”.
- Select the forms you need for the appropriate academic year and print them.
- Follow the instructions on the reverse side, Step 3 “Submit Required Documents”.

To access your student email:

- In MyPortal, log in and access email via the “My Student Email” option.

OR

- In WebAdvisor, click on “Access your Student Email Account” to log into your email or to reset your password.
- Check your email frequently for updates to your award eligibility and announcements.
